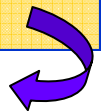

Bring school supplies to Israel for an Ethiopian-Israeli child in need.

- 1. Contact NACOEJ in the New York office:

- 2. Collect supplies on your own or through a school supplies drive.
- 3. Bring a bag with you as one of your allowed pieces of check-in luggage.
- 4. We will pick up the bags from anywhere in Jerusalem.
OR, you can bring them to our Jerusalem office.
- 5. NACOEJ staff members will see that the supplies are distributed to excited Ethiopian-Israeli children.

Please Bring:

- Markers
- Calculators

- Safety Scissors
- **NEW** School Bags (Backpacks)
- Scotch Tape
- Metric Rulers
- Glue Sticks
- Large Erasers (not pencil-end size)
- Pencil Pouches
- Geometry Sets
- Jump Ropes
- Deflated Balls
- Small Black Dolls
- Checker Sets (not Chinese checkers)
- Pens and Pencils

*These items are NOT
needed by our students in
Israel.*

PLEASE DO NOT BRING:

- Binders
- Notebooks
- Loose paper
- Pads of paper
- Clothing
- Chalk
- Thumbtacks
- Non-educational toys
- Games requiring English
- Paperclips
- Food or toilet articles of any kind

Please call us at least two weeks before your flight The NACOEJ New York office will make arrangements with the Israel office. NACOEJ Israel staff will pick up the supplies from anywhere in Jerusalem.

Because of current economic circumstances, it is financially difficult for NACOEJ to accept supplies shipped to the New York office, which then must be shipped further. Anyone collecting supplies is asked to find friends or relatives who can bring the supplies to Israel. Supplies cannot be mailed or shipped to Israel.

All school supplies are used in the NACOEJ Limudiah Program: Intensive After-School Education for Ethiopian-Israeli Children, which also needs financial assistance.

Please consider contributing to this essential cause.

- \$11,200 covers all Limudiah expenses for a whole class for one school year, including a hot lunch.
- \$1,400 can sponsor a child to participate in a Limudiah program for a year.
- \$750 can cover the cost of books and school supplies for 20 students in the Limudiah for one year.
- \$140 can sponsor a child in our Limudiah for a month.
- \$36 can buy schoolbooks for at least two Ethiopian-Israeli elementary school children who could not otherwise afford them.
